Our Holy Father Abraham of Smolensk

Born in the town of Smolensk at the prayers of his parents,
he early embraced the monastic state and gave himself to
strict asceticism, emulating the holy fathers of the desert.
He later founded the Monastery of the Holy Cross in
Smolensk. He underwent many temptations from demons
and from men, enduring them with great fortitude and
thanksgiving to God. At a time of great drought, he brought
rain by his prayers. Living fifty years in asceticism, he
entered peacefully into rest in the Lord in about 1220.
